This couple live on the east side of the city of Moncton in New Brunswick, Canada. Their neighbourhood is quiet and located in the hub of the Maritimes. Within one hour's drive are many tourist attractions, and they are 30 minutes drive away from the unique Parlee Beach which has the warmest salt water north of the Carolinas. 30 minutes drive, south, are 'The Rocks' where the high tides of the Bay of Fundy have carved spectacular rock formations. Fundy National Park is 1 hr away. This area is 'nature at its best', with 80square miles of spectacular rocky coastline, wildlife, walking and hiking trails, fishing and more. Cape Enrage is a picturesque scene of a lighthouse, rappelling down steep cliffs, and sea kayaking below.

Moncton has an active French speaking Acadian population and Le Pays de la Sagoine, 45 minutes drive is a 'must see'. Experience there the joie de vivre of the Acadian culture. From Moncton, cross the Confederation Bridge to Prince Edward Island, 1 hrs drive-(land of Anne of Green Gables): Travel to Halifax, Nova Scotia 2 ½ hrs and the state of Maine-3hrs.
