Conwy is a small, walled town dating from the 13th century, and a World Heritage Site. This large detached house, approximately 100 years old, is located within the mediaeval town walls. From the house are lovely views of Conwy Castle, the hills and estuary. The bedroom available to house-swappers is on the 2nd floor with a shower and separate toilet, and a kitchen-diner with microwave, washing-machine & tumble dryer. The large sloping garden is enclosed within the town walls and includes a turret and private steps up onto the walls. the garden is mainly laid to lawn, with fruit trees, flowerbeds, and a

small pond. There is garden furniture available. Parking is on the street, unless you have a small car and can navigate our narrow drive!

St Mary's Conwy is a traditional Church of Wales. About 50 people attend the morning service which is in English, with a mid-week communion on Wednesdays.
