Half of this house was built over 300 years ago and it was extended in 1915. There are very few right-angles in the house! Downstairs is a kitchen/little sitting room, toilet, separate dining room and a larger sitting room. There are 2 cottage style staircases and upstairs are the three double bedrooms & 2 bathrooms. (The office space is not available) Recently the solid fuel Rayburn has been replaced by an electric range cooker with induction hob, and the house is heated with storage heaters. This makes it easier to manage and more environmentallyfriendly than the solid fuel. There is still a coal fire in the sitting room which is necessary for

additional heat on a colder evening. There is a nice conservatory which leads into the enclosed back garden which has a table-tennis table, swing seat and built-in BBQ. This is fairly small but a lovely place to relax and enjoy eating *al fresco* on a warm summer's evening!
