This large family home is situated in the small rural hamlet of Kersewell in South Lanarkshire, just 30 minutes south of Edinburgh city bypass.

It is set amongst rolling hills in the Scottish Lowlands, close to Edinburgh and Glasgow & just south of the Pentland Hills. The nearest shops & eating places are 2 miles away making a car essential. This is a wonderful area to holiday. See websites below.

This spacious new build home is ideal for families who love the outdoors, but would also suit couples.

There is a very large kitchen, (50m<sup>2</sup>), one of the bedrooms is ensuite & there are 2 other bathrooms. Heating is CO<sub>2</sub> neutral: they have a pellet boiler which needs filling twice a week, which is easy to do. Home-owners will explain it to house swappers. There is an additional wood burner/stove in the kitchen.

The garden is large & enclosed with fencing. Children will be delighted to discover the Wendy House, tree house, slide, swing set, sandpit & trampoline. They have garden furniture and a BBQ. There is a lovely woodland area behind the house, wonderful walking ground.

Local places of interest	New Lanark UNESCO world heritage site 9 miles, All the mayor tourist attractions of Edinburgh (Castle, Zoo, Royal Mile, Art Galleries, National Museum, etc), Stirling Castle and Glasgow are only an hour drive away. Loch Lomond: 1:30 min, Glencoe: 2:30 min. The Tweed Valley and the Clyde Valley are wonderful walking grounds. -
