This mid-terraced house was built in the early 1900's and is situated within a 5 minute stroll of the lovely Lowestoft Beach and Seafront, along with its Harbour and Yacht Club. This is a charming town-house just a 5-10 minute drive to the beautiful Suffolk Broads, abounding with boats of all descriptions! 'Kensington Gardens' with model boat pond, bowling green, and tennis courts is a short walk up along the seafront. In the opposite direction, is the 'Sparrows Nest Gardens' and north beach.

This home is light and spacious, and perfect for a house-swap holiday, especially due to its close proximity to a beautiful big beach. 'The Sunshine

Coast' of Lowestoft is conveniently placed for visiting the many attractive towns & villages in this lovely County of Suffolk, and the adjoining County of Norfolk. "We're confident that house-swappers will appreciate the beauty & convenience of this region as much as we do!" Within 5-10 minutes walk are several shops, eating places, Asda & Co-op. It's about 15 minutes walk to the town centre.

House-swappers have access to the hallway, kitchen, lounge, stairs, landing, bathroom, separate cloakroom/w.c. and the 5 bedrooms. The lounge has a big screen as a receptor, but no actual TV. There's a PS4 which we use to watch DVDs of which there are a good selection available on the lounge shelf, as well as a few classic boardgames.

The bathroom is spacious with a walk in shower, large free-standing bath, 'his' and 'hers' sinks, w.c. and bidet. There is only one bathroom in the house, but 3 toilets. Each bedroom has a desk, a desk chair and DAB radio. All the mattresses are comfortable. The single bedroom has a memory foam mattress on an electric bed, and is quite small, but still has space for a chest of drawers and hanging rail.

The small enclosed garden is accessed through the kitchen and there are garden table & chairs, an 8ft trampoline, & a bike in the outbuilding, which is available to use...may need pumping up. There is free on-road parking.

The family attend 'Oulton Broad Free Presbyterian Church, on Victoria Road, and this is a pleasant half an hours walk away, or 10 minute drive. There are 2 services each Sunday & prayer mtg/Bible Study on Weds evenings. This is a small but genuine & very friendly fellowship and house-swappers would receive a warm welcome. And there are several other churches in the town.
