This mid 1990's terraced house is located in a quiet cul-de-sac on the edge of the lovely coastal town of Carrickfergus.

The home is near to the harbour/marina, so only 2 minutes walk to lovely sea views. The town centre is walking distance, and the nearest shop and eating places are within 10 minutes walk. It is 25 minutes drive from Belfast with all its marvellous amenities and places of interest for all age groups.

There is a bus stop within 5 mins walk and the train station is 15 mins walk. However, a car is necessary to fully appreciate the area including the beautiful scenic Antrim Coastal drive to Whitehead, Larne and further afield to the Giant's Causeway and Portrush

on the North Coast. See area websites below.

There is a small garden which is an enclosed paved area with flower tubs, garden table chairs & a 2-seater bench is at the front of the house. There is off-road parking, Sky TV but no wifi.

The owner attends Carrickfergus Vineyard Church, where about 150 people meet for Sunday mornings' contemporary worship with great teaching. This is a friendly fellowship and house-swappers are sure to receive a warm welcome if they go along.
