This 1950's semi-detached house is situated on a quiet road in the village of Churchdown which is situated halfway between Cheltenham and Gloucester. They are very close to the local pub, Indian and Chinese takeaway, coffee shop & a corner shop. They are also close to lovely country walks on nearby Churchdown Hill. This is a great location in itself, as well as being close to many beautiful towns and villages, surrounded by wonderful countryside. Bristol is under an hour's drive and Birmingham just over an hour. See area websites below.

The home is quite spacious with a well designed open plan kitchen, diner and breakfast bar. There is a separate TV room with Netflix. There are two bath/shower rooms and an additional downstairs toilet.

The enclosed garden is large, mostly private and laid to lawn with flower borders, shrubs and trees at the side, including an apple tree. The decking at the back of house has steps leading into garden. There is garden furniture and a BBQ.
