The property is a large ground floor apartment with a garden alongside the Thames river. The location is very close to central London (3.5 miles from Tower bridge), but due to it being on the Isle of Dogs, inside a loop of the Thames, it is relatively quiet with no through traffic. There is a riverside walkway/cycle path outside the garden, and a Thames sand/shingle beach by the back gate. There are great river views from all windows looking across to the Millennium Dome.

There are excellent connections to central London with DLR trains (7 minute walk) and Underground station (Jubilee line).

The apartment is on the ground floor, 6 floors to the block, and it was originally 2 apartments that have been connected together, and therefore could be disconnected if needed (via door) to allow separate facilities e.g. for grandparents staying with family. There are 2 separate front doors, 2 sitting rooms (one with TV), 3 toilets/bathrooms/shower and 2 kitchens, all ground floor. Being in an apartment the family has lots of close neighbours who are kind and helpful, and it's a close and friendly community. They

try to respect other residents by keeping the garden noise down before 10am and after 10pm (especially the trampoline use).

The medium sized garden runs alongside the apartment and is totally enclosed with a gate directly on to the river path. It's mostly laid to lawn with shrubs, patio areas, garden chairs & table, and a fire basket. There are also the following:- 13' rectangular trampoline with net surround, go karts, a range of bikes, gym mats and a beam. And a full size table tennis table in the garden, and pool/snooker table indoors!

Anyone who has a Kayak/Canoe/sailing boat can launch it from the beach by the back gate (slip way there), as no permits are required on the tidal stretches of the Thames. The beach there is great for paddling & playing with sand in the summer. There is off-road parking with permits available for as many cars as needed. The property is now inside the ULEZ zone but not inside the congestion zone. 5 mins walk is corner shop & 10 to Asda; within 10 mins walk to eating places.


