This 1908 end-terraced house is situated 15 minutes' walk from the centre of Windsor and 10 minutes to the river Thames. Literally next door is a recreation ground with parking, and a fantastic playground. They live on a suburban road and though busy, it has great amenities within 2 minutes walk including Tesco Express, Coop, Costa, restaurants and take-aways.

They are just a few minutes drive from the M4, and central London is an easy half hour drive away. The train station is just 20 mins walk from the house, with trains into central London and elsewhere. Bus stop right next door with regular service. The small enclosed garden has a sandpit and fold-able climbing frame with slide & balance beam etc in the shed, as well as a play-house. Although the garden is quite small there is quick and easy access to the recreational ground next door with play equipment, table tennis and MUGA pitches. There is no off-road parking but the car park next door makes it easy with kids & there's usually a space outside the house too. They have a pass which gives access to the various car parks in the royal landscapes of Windsor Great Park and Virginia Water. This will be available for house-swappers.
