This 1950's semi-detached home is situated in the south area of Reading town which is a good location for a combination of city life and lovely country areas to enjoy for a great holiday! There are lots of amenities within easy walking distance: shops, park, playing fields, sports centre, swimming pool. There are also many interesting activities and places to visit within a short drive so this is a good base from which to explore the area.

They are also very close to the M4 junction, countryside football stadium, and a very frequent bus route into town. London Paddington is just over 20mins by train from the town centre, enabling easy access for great days out in London.

Downstairs is a sunny living room with TV, children's toys & keyboard. The dining room can seat 8, the kitchen is small but functional, (no dishwasher), utility room and an unheated toilet which is fine in the warmer weather! A side door leads out into the garden. Upstairs is the bathroom with a separate toilet, one small single, one large single and a double bedroom. The bed arrangement is a bit flexible, currently sleeps 4-6 if two are young children. They have 2 x cot/toddler beds that can be used if needed in either the single or double room.

The large enclosed garden is mostly laid to lawn with shrubs, veg patch and trees. A large apple tree is good for shade and climbing.... and apples! It's a great garden for sitting in the sunshine and children playing. They have garden chairs, a small table and a gas BBQ. There is a shallow pond which is covered by a safety mesh to stop young children falling in.



The side of the garden is open to the front garden which is only enclosed by a normal latch gate, so young children that like exploring will need watching! Children will be pleased to discover the sandpit, tree swing, trampoline, small slide and Wendy house. They have some sports equipment and garden games (kubb, croquet) which house-swappers are welcome to use. It might be possible to borrow bikes. There is off-road parking.

The 2 Chickens are normally free range but can be shut away in their run if preferred.


