This single storey Lodge has a beautiful, rural Cornish location! The lanes are narrow, but accessible & there are distant views of the sea. The North coast beaches are 5miles away & South coast beaches are 7 miles. This is a marvellous area to holiday with so much to see & do & enjoy! Many lovely local towns and villages e.g.:- St Ives- 7miles, Penzance - 10 miles, Truro - 11miles.



The Lodge is all on one level, 1200 sq feet approx. It comprises a fitted kitchen, 2 lounges, dinning room, one of the bedrooms has an ensuite toilet/shower, another bathroom, a utility room with washing machine, dryer and shower. (There are 3 toilets in all)

The TV has a 65inch screen, & also available is 40inch Netflix , Amazon, YouTube, Disney. There is a CD player and 2 sound systems. They are on wifi with fibre broadband.

House-swappers will be delighted to discover the very large open garden

and outdoor area. There is a swimming pool, play equipment and trampoline, as well as garden table, chairs and a BBQ! (Care of the pool is done by Plantation Christian Community)
