This early 1950's detached bungalow is situated in a lovely rural location, on a quiet road surrounded on 3 sides by open fields. The nearest pub is half a mile away in the village and the nearest shop is 1 ½ miles. The attractive and interesting market town of Diss is 8 miles away, Stowmarket is 6 miles, and the whole area has many lovely Suffolk villages. 'This is a gentle county with very friendly people' It offers a peaceful

place to holiday, but there are lots of tourist attractions within 30 miles, and many sporting activities, so can be action packed if desired!

The house has a large kitchen/diner, separate conservatory, large lounge, 3 bedrooms, one of which is ensuite, & a bathroom. The good-sized partially enclosed garden is mostly laid to lawn which surrounds the bungalow, and also flower beds, shrubs and trees. There is a patio area with garden table and chairs. Wildlife can regularly be seen including pheasants, partridges, hares and deer.

Mickfield Evangelical Church is very friendly and about 100 people gather for the Sunday morning services and then 60-70 in the evenings. There is a good mix of traditional and contemporary worship with very good Bible teaching. Visitors would receive a great welcome!
