This modern, good-sized detached house is situated in a quiet, friendly village, just down the road from the village hall, which has a busy social programme. Surrounded by beautiful scenery, there is a river, woodland and hills making this a wonderful choice for anyone enjoying walking, biking or just relaxing in a beautiful setting. This whole part of

Carmarthenshire is relatively unspoilt and undiscovered.

Carmarthen is the nearest large town, about 20mins/7miles drive away for theatre, bowling, cinema, the castle, a range of shops and some excellent eating places. Within less than an hour's drive is the coast at Ceredigion, Carmarthenshire or Pembrokeshire. (See area websites below.)

The family areas of the house comprise a large family lounge, large kitchen-breakfast room with utility room attached, dining room and downstairs toilet. They have Sky TV with films, prime and Netflix. There's wifi throughout and a piano and guitar. The house is quite large and spacious. Laminate or hard flooring throughout except stairs and landing which are carpeted, so easy to clean.

There are private gardens with 2 patios and vegetable and flower beds to the rear, ample off-road tarmacked parking and grassed areas at the front. The back lawn is big enough for ball games and running around. There is a garage suitable for storing bikes and other outdoor equipment. It is not a carefully manicured garden so there are plenty of slightly wild bits round the edges and corners.



A car is advisable here as it's a rural area. There are 2 buses a day however. They also have a pod-point for charging electric vehicles if needed. There is a large playing field opposite the property.

Five Saints Church, Llanpumsaint, Church in Wales, is very friendly and welcoming. Church events are advertised on the village website and Facebook pages.
