This late 1950's detached home is situated at the southern end of Meppershall Village, in a quiet rural cul-de-sac opposite St Mary's Church. The House is in the corner of a field grazed by the farmer's horse. The John Bunyan Trail runs through the field, providing access to beautiful walks and views of the surrounding

countryside from high ground. Nearby is the market town of Shefford, with Bedford and Hitchin further afield. They are just 3 mins walk to the local bakery, and the village store, post office and pub are ¼ mile away; an ideal location to explore this lovely county.

The house comprises a Lounge, Dining Room with high chair, Kitchen with dishwasher& microwave, downstairs toilet, utility room with washing machine & dryer, Internet and TV with Sky Basic and Amazon Prime.
