This fascinating property was formerly 3 cottages built in the late 1800's. It has been renovated into a detached home and is situated in the Afan Forest Park, in the village of Pontrhydyfen. Surrounded by hills and beautiful scenery, the house is set back from the main road with views through the valley, offering great walks. It is 10-15 minutes drive to a town either side with plenty of amenities, entertainment and shops. It's also 15 minutes drive to the beach with cafés, ice cream, surfing and long promenade. This is a marvellous location for a holiday! Just across the road is a corner shop and a 'takeaway', and food-pub within walking distance.


There are 3 Reception rooms:- The main living room with TV, Netflix, Prime, Now TV and DVD player; a small reception room with TV and Xbox, and a 3rd reception with electric piano. 
