This mid 1930's terraced town house is situated on a pleasant residential road in West Wickham. This is an outer London suburban area which is easily accessible to all that London offers, as well as the lovely Kent countryside with its many & varied tourist attractions. Half a mile away is the railway station with trains to central London. There are some lovely walks on local commons. West Wickham is in the London Borough of Bromley. It is on the line of a Roman road, the London to Lewes Way, and is east of Croydon and south west of Bromley.

The garden is enclosed & mainly laid to lawn, bordered by shrubs & flower beds. There is also a patio with garden furniture. Off-road parking is available in front of the house. Selection of photos below.
