Woodley is a medium-sized town near Reading very close to nice countryside and the Thames. This mid 1990's detached house is located in a well designed modern housing area, just 5-6 mins walk to a local shop and a 10-15 minute walk to eating several places and shopping precinct. At the front of the house is a small grassy open area, while the back garden is enclosed and has a lawn and decking area. They have a barbecue and garden table &

chairs. There is a summer house too. Plenty of space to park 1-2 cars on the driveway. There is a good bus service from their road straight into the middle of Reading. (30 min ride) *More house photos below*.

Beside the house a pathway leads through to the woods, open parkland and a lake. There are 3 childrens' play areas very close by. The family's favourite walk includes a long stretch of river, views of lakes, a ford, a pack of alpacas and a very pretty country pub!

The lovely Dinton Pastures country park and nature reserve with an award winning nature play area and 7 lakes & 2 rivers is less than a mile. Woodley is a great base for touring the rest of Berkshire and beyond, including Henley, Windsor, the Chilterns and the Thames Path.

Emmanuel is an Anglican Church where 90-100 people meet for Sunday morning and enjoy a very contemporary style of worship. The church is very informal and welcoming. There are lots of children and separate activities for them, including a host of wonderful puppets to enjoy!
