This beautiful detached cottage is situated on a guiet residential lane, dating back to the 1600s. The beautiful village of Harwell is home to approx. 2000 people living in a variety of houses including many from the Middle and Tudor times. The Ages immediate locality offers great walks and lovely views of the Oxfordshire countryside. Two miles to the east, is the town of Didcot, with а range of independent and high-street

shops, and eating places. The city of Oxford is just 30 minutes by car, or walk a couple of minutes to a nearby bustop to travel by bus or train. The city needs little introduction as a marvellous place to visit for its museums and historic interest.

As well as the main sitting room with fireplace there is a kitchen-diner and small utility. Outside there is an enclosed garden with patio, small Summer house and the actual well of Harwell! Whilst it is a historic building, there are many modern features including gas central heating, an induction cooker, fan oven, dishwasher, washing machine and tumble dryer. Up a steep staircase is a bathroom with toilet, bath (with shower attachment) and two basins.

The local butcher & general village store is just 5-10 minutes walk away, as is the nearest pub, which also serves good food.

St. Matthews Harwell and All Saints Chilton are two rural parishes, and there is a good mix of traditional and contemporary styles of worship in both. Children from birth to age 16 are catered for with groups running, during the 9.30am, 10.30 and sometimes evening services. About 80 people attend St Matthews in the main 10.30 am service.

Oxford colleges, Museum of Nat. History, + much more in city, see Oxford websites. Blenheim Palace, Stratford, Henley, Warwick & easy access to London, by car, bus or train.
