The beautiful village of Harwell is home to approx. 2000 people living in a variety of houses including many from the Middle Ages and Tudor times. The immediate locality is fairly rural, consisting of farm land and small villages, so offers great walks and lovely views of the Oxfordshire countryside. Also, just two miles to the East, is the town of Didcot, with a range of independent and high-street shops. The city of Oxford is just 30 minutes by car and needs little introduction as a marvellous place to visit for its museums and historic interest.

This 1960's, large detached home is situated at the end of a quiet lane. The local butcher & general village store is just 5 minutes walk away, as is the nearest pub, which

also serves good food. A good sized garden surrounds the property on all sides including an orchard, fruit and vegetable plot, small wooded area, lawn and stream. Children will be delighted to discover a range of outdoor ride-on toys, a large trampoline, bikes & football goals.

St. Matthews Harwell and All Saints Chilton are two rural parishes and there is a good mix of traditional & contemporary styles of worship in both. Children from birth to age 16 are catered for with groups running, during the 9.30am, 11am and evening services. About 100 people attend St Matthews in the main 11 am service.
