This attractive detached house is situated in a village, close to the small town of Asfeld in the district of Vogelsbergkreis, central Germany. The area is located on an extinct volcano which was last active 7 million years ago, so there are many hills and interesting landscapes. Asfeld is a beautiful old medieval town which has a local market twice a week, a museum and a fairytale house, since it's in the centre of the Grimm's collection of fairytales! Surrounded by forest, the town has good amenities which includes a variety of shops, a swimming pool, a skater park, several playgrounds and a little pond. The town hall is

500 years old and very pretty. This is a wonderful location to holiday having many great places to visit and things to do for all age groups.

There are hourly train and bus routes to neighbouring small and larger towns and cities around. Gießen is the nearest large city, followed by Frankfurt.

The house has two bathrooms, one with a bathtub, one with a shower, each has a toilet. There is a piano in the basement and Netflix access is available. In the barn is wood for the wood stove where you also can cook upon, but there is a conventional electric stove in the kitchen. There is a small fireplace.

The garden is large where the chickens are allowed to run free during the autumn and winter. Garden chairs and table and a barbecue are present.

The garden is mostly laid to grass and there are some apple trees, two cherry trees and a peach tree. House-swappers are welcome to enjoy the fruit if ripe when you are staying... and also to use the bikes, 2 mens and 1 womans.

Visiting house-swappers will be given a warm welcome to the Evangelische Stadtmmission, translated - Evangelical City Mission Church in Asfeld. The services are all in German, the worship a mix of traditional and contemporary, and the worship is

universal! Several people in the congregation speak English. Using translation, their website is bright and informative, and they clearly have a heart for the community.
