The location is the Abruzzo region of Italy. This 1940's detached bungalow is situated on a hill with views of olive trees & the valley to the front. At the back is a mountain range with the magnificent Gran Sasso peak visible.

The seaside town of Pescara, on the Adriatic is 10 miles away. Here are wonderful sandy beaches, a variety of amenities including the train station, shops & great eating places. This is a marvellous location to holiday! The house itself is in a rural setting amongst a small group of houses with friendly neighbours.

The nearest shop is 3 miles away in the village of Moscufo. House-swappers would need to hire a car to get around, though it's an easy motorway journey from the UK if people wanted to come by car. Flights (Ryanair) from Stansted to Pescara or scheduled flights from the UK to Rome (approx 2 hours by car to Pescara). Pescara airport approx 6 miles from their home. There is a bus stop 500yards away with a regular bus service to Pescara. Below are websites about the area.

The enclosed garden has a small lawn & tiled flooring. Attractive plants in pots adorn the garden & available is outdoor furniture & a barbecue. The house is well equipped and will provide a wonderful opportunity for enjoying this beautiful part of Italy. Below are a few photos of the property and outside space.
