The Veluwe is an attractive wooded area which is particularly suitable for walking, cycling and mountain biking. About 18 km are some large places; Apeldoorn (Loo Palace) Harderwijk (dolfinarium). There are train connections to Rotterdam and



Amsterdam. The Randmeer is about 20 km away and there are several characteristic fishing villages nearby. There is a bus service every hour. The detached house was built in 2019 and is located in a beautiful area with a garden of approx. 3000 square meters. There is garden furniture and a barbecue. For the children there is a trampoline and swing.

The family attends the Dutch Reformed Church where 400 people gather for the morning service and about 200 in the evening.
