This late 1970's terraced house is situated in a quiet residential neighbourhood.

It's a wonderful location just '5 minutes walk to beautiful dunes where you can walk or cycle endlessly'. They are 15 min walk from the sea & there are lots of funny restaurants and bars on the beach. Even if the weather is windy and cold, one can still enjoy watching the sea from a warm place behind the windows of the restaurants. Buses go to Leiden Central station(40 min). Another bus stop is 10 min walk and the bus there goes to the Hague. Schiphol airport is 25 min. drive and Amsterdam 35 min. Cities like Leiden and The Hague are even closer. There

is a railway station 5 km away with free parking. Parking in the neighbourhood is free. 'We have 5 grown-up children who are all willing to help you in case of any problem.'

The private garden is about 80 sq metres and mostly laid to lawn with garden table & chairs and a barbecue, which is old but quite serviceable. The couple love to sit & relax in the sunshine, or shade on a hot day. They have wind-breaks & beach tents to take to the beach if house-swappers would like to use.
