This beautiful sunny home is situated in the attractive small village of Bennekom, central in the Netherlands and near to the big heather field, “de Hoge Veluwe“ National Park. The area is one of differing landscapes and woodlands with good walking and biking trails. It is near the famous river ‘de Rijn’ in Wageningen (the well known city of the life science, an international university of agriculture and the city of capitulation.)

Amsterdam is about one hour by train, Utrecht 30 minutes by car, and the German border about 1 hour's drive. There is much to discover and enjoy in this area, making it a great choice to holiday. See area websites below.

All in walking distance are supermarkets, butcher, flower shops, clothes, pharmacy and some bars/eating places. The railway station is 5 km, about 7 minutes by car, and local bus stops are about 200 meters. They will take you to the train station or to the centre bus station in Wageningen for cities buses connections.

Built in 1975 this semi-detached house is warm and welcoming! There are some toys, and board games for all ages. The private and enclosed back yard is a small, beautiful garden laid to lawn with shrubs, flower borders and some small fruit trees. This is a delightful place to relax and enjoy eating 'al fresco' on a warm summers' evening'! They have garden table, chairs and a barbecue. House-swappers are asked to water the garden please, if staying during a dry spell.

Public transport in the Netherlands is well known as very good, by train or by bus, efficient and punctual. “But normally we will take the bike for almost everything”. Two ladies & two men's bikes are available to use. And for swapping outside of Europe they are happy to discuss car swapping.

The couple are active members of an evangelical church in Wageningen, and while the services are in Dutch, there is an audio translator to English. There are about 120

people in the congregation (pre-covid) and there is a good mix of contemporary and traditional worship. More info on their website :- www.salemwageningen.nl

Sport's facilities	Within walking distance: tennis, basketball, football, sport centres, open air swimming pool is 2km. Also playgrounds & fenced football field open for kids to play at the primary school yard, 200 meters

Queen Palace, "Paleis het Loo" in Apeldoorn, open for public is about 45 minutes by car Castle "Doorwerth", Zoo's and safari park, 15 to 20 mins drive, Small castle "Hoekelum" in Bennekom is 10 minutes biking Theatre is about 10 minutes biking Open air museum in Arnhem, 20 mins by car; 'Farmers' Summer festivals in Bennekom, 'Leef' festivals in Wageningen
