This ground floor flat is part of a stylish block of 3 storey flats & houses built around 1900. They are situated in a quiet residential area on the outskirts of Dresden. In front is a square park with lots of trees, bushes and three playgrounds. A selection of eating places are within 500 metres. Dresden is the capital of Saxonia, located between the Iron Oar Mountains and the Sandstone Mountains, making this a wonderful area for hiking, climbing, bird watching etc. Close by are

Meissen, famous for china, and Leipzig with its famous zoo, as well as many other interesting towns & tourist attractions. See area websites below.

'There are excellent transport links with two bus stops for two lines (90,63) just 50 meters away, where you can change to the citywide tram after two stops. There is also S-Bahn for longer rides in the area & the train station is easy to get to by bus or tram. It's perfect....and house-swappers are welcome to use our two bikes'.







The entrance of the flats is laid to attractive mosaic flooring and inside consists of a living-room, bedroom, extra room with bed, kitchen with eating area and work space, bathroom with toilet and an extra guest toilet.

They have a fully equipped kitchen as well as a power mixer/smoothie maker & slow cooker in two sizes. They stream Amazon and Disney +, both available in English, and there are lots of English novels and children's books in the house.

The terrace is their private outside sitting area which seats 4, as well as 5 extra chairs. They have an electric BBQ, a parasol, and some lovely plants mostly in pots which will need watering please! There is also a 2×2 metre sandpit.
