Whaley Bridge is a fairly quiet village on the edge of the Peak District National Park. There is a reservoir in the village with a sailing club. This is a wonderful area for walking, cycling, climbing and generally exploring. It is seven miles from the developing spa town of Buxton, & a ¾ hour drive or train ride to the thriving cities of Manchester & Sheffield.

This mid 1930's semi-detached house is on the main B road to Macclesfield, but the property is set back from the road so it's not too noisy. They have off-road parking on the front drive. There is an enclosed back garden mostly laid to lawn with flower borders, a sitting area with garden table & chairs & a barbecue.

The Anglican churches of Holy Trinity & St James Parish enjoy a traditional form of worship to which there are about 30 people in the morning congregation. The home owners will leave a welcome & info list for house swappers so they know what's going on in their church & local community.
