This 1930's detached house is situated in a cul-de-sac off the main road, so is fairly quiet and a nice residential area. It is easy walking distance to local shops and restaurants. The house is in the town of Poole which is 15 minutes drive to the nearest beach. This is a great location to holiday, enabling easy access for exploring the wonderful county of Dorset.

The home is on 3 levels & the double bedroom is in the loft area. They have a modern kitchen/diner & separate sitting room. The medium-sized enclosed garden is mostly laid to lawn with flower borders, garden chairs, a bench & a barbecue. There is a large netted trampoline

& a fish-pond. Children will be pleased to discover the garden box of outdoor toys available, as well as Badminton rackets and net. There is off-road parking, on the drive.

The family attend St Mary's Longfleet, Poole. This is a large and thriving fellowship with around 400 people attending the Sunday morning service and 300 in the evening! The 9-15 am service is fairly traditional with 150 in the congregation. Both the 10:45 am & the evening services are very contemporary in style.
