This 1960's linked detached bungalow is situated in a quiet cul de sac on the edge of town, very close to the Southdowns National Park. Most of the properties are bungalows, and they have parking on their driveway for 2 cars. Seaford is a thriving seaside town with a population of 28,000. From their home are lovely walks to the sea with views to the Seven Sisters Cliffs and Beachy Head. Buses close by to travel to Brighton or Eastbourne, and within 50 miles there are 11 National Trust properties! There is no charge for parking on the sea front and in town (2 hour limit). Their nearest shop is just 5

mins walk and nearest eating places 1 mile away in town. Morrisons is the main supermarket; Lidl and Sainsbury's 4 miles away.

There are TV sets in the reception rooms and all bedrooms. They have Freeview giving about 80 channels. The double bedroom is ensuite, and then a separate bathroom and toilet. The middle bedroom is also the sunroom, and all bedrooms have access to the rear garden.

The utility room has a washing machine and tumble drier (for winter use only; 2 clothes lines for use 9 months of the year) The medium sized garden is mostly laid to lawn with a raised flower bed and patio areas. 
