This mid 1960's semi-detached house is situated on a quiet road on the edge of the small town of Milngavie on the outskirts of Glasgow, 8 miles away. Beautiful open countryside is on their doorstep; 30 minutes to a loch and 5 minutes to a wide range of grocery stores and restaurants. Milngavie is in East Dunbartonshire, in the valley of the River Allander which is known for

being the starting point of the West Highland Way.

The house comprises:- a kitchen with washing machine, dishwasher etc, separate dining room, 2 living rooms, a downstairs bathroom and a small conservatory. They have good WiFi and TV with Netflix. There are great views from the house and garden.
