This wonderfully designed home was built 5 years ago and is a large detached chalet/ bungalow. It's situated 20 miles outside Freetown in Sierra Leone, and 35 mins from some of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Staying here in this secure environment offers a wonderful holiday experience. Interested house-swappers will have the opportunity to be in touch by phone or email to discuss life in S.L..



The house is set in 1 acre of land with a plunge pool overlooking a beautiful small lake. As well as the 6 bedrooms there are 4 bathrooms and spacious living areas inside and out, and a small guest cottage with its own shower and toilet. The location is village life but with an urban/rural blend. The nearest big shop is 10 miles while farm shops and cold drinks are 600 metres. The nearest eating place is 550 metres to a small hotel with pool, food and drinks. House swappers are welcome to use their bikes, and for other transport , taxi bikes, local busses and cheap taxis run from morning till about 11pm. It has a 20m glass frontage that all opens up to a large lawn with palm trees. The ceilings are high and helps keep the place cool. Lighting is solar from the Project (www.homeleone.org) solar installation and is switched off at 11pm.



There is a generator available afterward but needs to be “fed” . All the floors are carpet free. They have a good Yamaha sound system with Alexa.

There is night security 7 days a week and a cleaner comes in every day to assist with daily jobs. The house is in a fenced one acre site, part of a 25 acre “pilot village” which is still being built.

The garden is mostly laid to lawn with palm trees, lots of garden furniture and the lovely filtered plunge pool.

The couple serve as missionarries in S.L.. and have an international church meet at their house once a month when here.

Their home church in the UK is Ayelsbury Vale Community Church where they have been fellowshiping with them for 13 years and have known them for longer.
